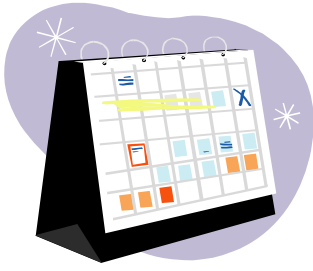
We offer:
